- ☐ The start of the event on both days will be from the area at the side of the security lodge at the entrance to Goudini Spa
- ☐ Ensure that you have sufficient fuel. Petrol is available in Rawsonville, from 'Agrimark' directly across the road from the Police Station or the Caltex Service Station, approximately 8 km from the Spa.
- ☐ Please be at the starting area at least 10 minutes before your start time.
- ☐ It is the responsibility of each motorcyclist to carry sufficient tie-downs and to secure his/her bike in the event of a breakdown.
- ☐ There has been a vast improvement in the quality of the meals in the restaurant should you not wish to self cater. There is also a shop in the complex which has been substantially upgraded.
- ☐ For those who have ordered refreshments and meals en-route, the vouchers will be in your smaller Documentation envelope. Please ensure that you have these vouchers at every meal and at refreshment times. No meals will be served without a voucher.
- ☐ Emergency numbers are included in your Documentation envelope and it is recommended that you carry these at all times for obvious reasons.
- ☐ We will do the seating for the prize-giving dinner. A seating plan will be displayed in the relevant restaurant or Conference Centre on Tuesday evening. (We anticipate 8 or 10 to a table).
